(\*) Note: In 2010, the official Christmas Day and Boxing Day Bank Holidays are on Monday 27 December and Tuesday 28 December respectively.

Christmas Day (Saturday 25 December 2010) is stated in the Regulations so Pharmacies are not required to open on this day in order to meet the requirement to open for 40 hours/100 hours per week. Monday 27 December 2010 has been declared a Bank Holiday so Pharmacies are not required to open on this day either in order to meet the requirement to open for 40 hours/100 hours per week. This means that as Monday 27 December 2010 is a Bank Holiday, the contractual hours that would have ordinarily been covered on this day are counted towards the 40 hours a week (or 100 hours for pharmacies that opened under that exemption) contractual hours requirement without the Pharmacy having been open.

However, Boxing Day (Sunday 26 December 2010) is not declared as a Bank Holiday, so Pharmacies that are normally open on Sundays will need to notify the PCT (with at least 90 days notice) if they intend to close on 26 December (if the hours are all supplementary), or apply (at least 90 days in advance) for permission to change core contractual hours (if the Sunday hours include core contractual hours).
