(\*) Note: In 2011, the official New Year's Day, Christmas Day and Boxing Day Bank Holidays are on Monday 3 January, Monday 26 December and Tuesday 27 December respectively.

For New Year's Day itself, Saturday 1 January 2011, Pharmacies that are normally open on Saturdays will need to notify the PCT (with at least 90 days notice) if they intend to close on 1 January (if the hours are all supplementary), or apply (at least 90 days in advance) for permission to change core contractual hours (if the Saturday hours include core contractual hours).
